BEAST FROM BELOW:The ascent of the final Beast power from the Abyss, releasing the imprisoned powers that have been bound since the days of Noah, making war on the saints and deceiving the whole world.

These two forces are on a collision course. One purifies. One destroys. One refines gold. One consumes chaff.

Your eternal destiny depends on which fire you prepare for.

A Word of Warning

This book will challenge you. It will demand that you let go of traditions you have held for years, perhaps decades. It will ask you to stand alone if necessary. It will prepare you for suffering, persecution, and martyrdom.

If you are looking for comfort, close this book now.

But if you are willing to be refined by fire now so that you can stand in the Fire later, read on.

"For Yahuah thy Elohim is a consuming fire, even a jealous Elohim." (Deuteronomy 4:24)

The King is coming.

And He is bringing the Fire.

PART 1: THE NATURE OF THE RETURN

"The Master Yahusha shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not Elohim." (2 Thessalonians 1:7-8)

CHAPTER 1: YAHUAH IS A CONSUMING FIRE

Most believers have been taught that Yahuah is love. And He is.

But they have not been taught that Yahuah is also fire. Consuming, purifying, all-devouring fire.

This is not a metaphor. This is His nature.

The Foundational Declaration

"For Yahuah thy Elohim is a consuming fire, even a jealous Elohim." (Deuteronomy 4:24)

Moses spoke these words to Israel after receiving the Torah on Mount Sinai — the mountain that burned with fire, where the people trembled in terror at Yahuah's presence.

This was not symbolic. The mountain literally blazed. The people literally heard His voice like thunder. Those who touched the mountain died.

"And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because Yahuah descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly." (Exodus 19:18)

Yahuah descended in fire. Not as fire — in fire. His presence manifests as flame.

Confirmed in the New Covenant

Fifteen hundred years after Moses, the writer of Hebrews reaffirms the same truth:

"For our Elohim is a consuming fire." (Hebrews 12:29)

Notice: present tense. Not "was" but "is." Yahuah has not changed. He is still fire.

The same chapter warns:

"See that ye refuse not Him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused Him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from Him that speaketh from heaven: Whose voice then shook the earth: but now He hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven." (Hebrews 12:25-26)

When Yahuah spoke at Sinai, the earth shook. When He speaks again at the return of Yahusha, both heaven and earth will shake.

And the shaking will be by fire.

The Return Will Be in Fire

When Yahusha returns, He does not come as the suffering servant. He comes as the conquering King.

In flaming fire.

"And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Master Yahusha shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not Elohim, and that obey not the gospel of our Master Yahusha Messiah." (2 Thessalonians 1:7-8)

Notice the targets of this fire:

The fire is not random. It is judicial. It targets disobedience.

The Day That Burns Like an Oven

The prophet Malachi describes the Day of Yahuah's return with terrifying clarity:

"For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith Yahuah of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch." (Malachi 4:1)

An oven. Complete combustion. Total consumption.

The proud and the wicked will burn like stubble — dry straw thrown into flame. Nothing will remain.

Not root. Not branch. Total annihilation.

Chariots of Fire

Isaiah adds the visual imagery:

"For, behold, Yahuah will come with fire, and with His chariots like a whirlwind, to render His anger with fury, and His rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire and by His sword will Yahuah plead with all flesh: and the slain of Yahuah shall be many." (Isaiah 66:15-16)

He comes with fire. His chariots are like whirlwinds. His rebuke is delivered with flames.

This is not the gentle shepherd imagery that modern churchgoers are comfortable with. This is the Warrior King, the Judge of all the earth, the Consuming Fire returning to cleanse His creation.

Why Fire?

Fire does two things:

Yahuah's fire is not arbitrary destruction. It is purposeful purification.

When He returns, His presence will act as a furnace. What cannot survive the heat will be consumed. What can survive will be refined to purity.

The question is simple:

What are you made of?

Are you wood, hay, and stubble — built on the traditions of men, the doctrines of demons, the lies of Babylon?

Or are you gold, silver, and precious stones — built on the foundation of Torah, refined by trials, purified by obedience?

The fire will answer.

CHAPTER 2: THE REFINING FIRE VS. THE DESTROYING FIRE

Not all fire is the same.

The same flame that destroys chaff refines gold. The same furnace that consumes wood purifies silver.

The difference is not the fire. The difference is the material.

The Foundation You Build On

Paul explains the principle in his first letter to the Corinthians:

"For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Yahusha Messiah. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire." (1 Corinthians 3:11-15)

Notice the two categories of building materials:

CATEGORY 1: Gold, Silver, Precious Stones

CATEGORY 2: Wood, Hay, Stubble

Both builders claim to build on the foundation of Yahusha Messiah. But one builds with eternal materials. The other builds with temporal trash.

The fire reveals which is which.

What Does Each Material Represent?

Gold = Truth

Gold represents the pure Word of Yahuah. Torah. Commands. Unchanging truth.

"The law of Yahuah is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of Yahuah is sure, making wise the simple... More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold." (Psalm 19:7, 10)

If your foundation is built on obedience to Torah — the Sabbath, the feasts, the dietary laws, the sacred names — you are building with gold.

Silver = Redemption

Silver in Scripture represents redemption. The ransom price. The blood of the Lamb.

"Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; but with the precious blood of Messiah, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot." (1 Peter 1:18-19)

If your life is marked by repentance, forgiveness, and reliance on Yahusha's sacrifice, you are building with silver.

Precious Stones = Character Refined

Precious stones form under pressure. Heat. Time.

If your life shows the fruits of the Spirit — patience through trials, love through persecution, faithfulness through suffering — you are building with precious stones.

Wood, Hay, Stubble = The Traditions of Men

These are the lies of Babylon:

If your worship is built on Rome's changed times and laws, you are building with combustible materials.

The fire will consume them.

The Wheat and the Chaff

John the Baptist used agricultural imagery to describe the same principle:

"Whose fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly purge His floor, and gather His wheat into the garner; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire." (Matthew 3:12)

In ancient threshing, wheat and chaff were thrown into the air. The wind separated them. The heavy wheat fell to the ground. The light chaff blew away.

At the return of Yahusha, the same separation occurs — but the separating agent is fire, not wind.

Wheat (the righteous) is gathered. Chaff (the wicked) is burned.

Same plant. Different parts. One is valuable. One is waste.

The Refiner's Fire

Malachi describes the process of refining:

"But who may abide the day of His coming? and who shall stand when He appeareth? for He is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap: and He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and He shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto Yahuah an offering in righteousness." (Malachi 3:2-3)

A refiner does not destroy the metal. He purifies it.

The process:

When Yahusha returns, He will sit as the Refiner. He will heat the furnace. The dross of our lives — sin, pride, idolatry, disobedience — will rise to the surface.

If we are gold, the fire purifies us. We survive, refined to purity.

If we are dross, the fire consumes us. We are skimmed off and discarded.

Two Fires, One Flame

Here is the critical truth:

The same fire that refines the righteous destroys the wicked.

It is not two different fires. It is one fire, affecting two different materials in two different ways.

Peter describes the coming fire that will melt the elements:

"But the day of Yahuah will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up." (2 Peter 3:10)

The wicked are destroyed in this fire. But the righteous?

"Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness." (2 Peter 3:13)

The righteous pass through the fire and enter the new creation.

Not because they avoid the fire, but because they survive it.

The question remains:

What are you made of?

CHAPTER 3: WHY THE REFINED CAN STAND

If Yahuah is a consuming fire, and if the wicked are consumed when He returns, how can anyone survive?

The answer is found in the book of Daniel, chapter 3.

The Furnace Heated Seven Times Hotter

King Nebuchadnezzar commanded all the people to bow to his golden image. Three Hebrew men — Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego — refused.

The penalty was death by fire.

"Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: therefore he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated." (Daniel 3:19)

Seven times hotter than normal. So hot that the soldiers who threw them in were killed by the heat.

This furnace represents the final tribulation. The fire that will test all flesh.

The three Hebrews were bound and thrown into the flame.

And they did not burn.

"Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king. He answered and said, Lo, I

see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of Elohim." (Daniel 3:24-25)

Four men. Not three.

The fourth figure appeared in the fire. He was "like the Son of Elohim."

This is Yahusha, pre-incarnate, walking with His faithful ones in the furnace.

The Fire Only Burned Their Bonds

When the king called them out of the furnace, Scripture records:

"And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them." (Daniel 3:27)

The fire had no power over them.

Not a hair singed. Not a coat burned. Not even the smell of smoke.

But their bonds — the ropes that tied them — were burned away.

They went into the fire bound. They came out free.

The Prophetic Pattern

This is the pattern for the remnant at the return of Yahusha.

The fire will come. The furnace will be heated seven times hotter (the final tribulation).

The wicked will be consumed. But the righteous will walk through the flame unharmed.

Why?

Because Yahusha walks with them in the fire.

The fire does not destroy them. It liberates them. It burns away their bonds — the sins, the fears, the lies that held them captive.

They emerge from the fire purified, free, and glorified.

Why They Could Stand

What made the three Hebrews able to survive the fire?

1. They refused to compromise.

The king offered them a second chance. Bow, or burn.

"Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter. If it be so, our Elohim whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up." (Daniel 3:16-18)

"We will not serve thy gods."

Even if Yahuah does not deliver us, we will not bow.

This is the faith that survives the fire.

2. They had already been refined.

These men had been tested before. They refused the king's food (Daniel 1). They chose obedience over comfort, purity over promotion.

By the time they faced the furnace, the dross was already burned away.

The fire found nothing in them to consume.

3. Yahusha was with them.

The fourth figure appeared in the fire. They did not walk alone.

When you face the trials now — the smaller fires that prepare you for the greater Fire — Yahusha is with you.

"When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee." (Isaiah 43:2)

Not "if" you walk through fire. When.

The fire is guaranteed. But so is His presence.

Application for Today

The furnace of Daniel 3 is a preview of the fire at Yahusha's return.

Those who refuse the Mark (the golden image of the Beast) will face persecution, economic exclusion, and eventually a death decree (Revelation 13:15).

But those who stand firm — who refuse to bow, who trust Yahuah even if He does not deliver them from death — will walk through the fire unharmed.

The fire at the end is not meant to destroy you.

It is meant to burn away your bonds.

Are you willing to enter the furnace?

CHAPTER 4: NO ONE CAN SEE HIS FACE AND LIVE — UNLESS PURE

There is an apparent contradiction in Scripture.

On one hand:

"And He said, Thou canst not see My face: for there shall no man see Me, and live." (Exodus 33:20)

On the other hand:

"Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see Elohim." (Matthew 5:8)

"And they shall see His face; and His name shall be in their foreheads." (Revelation 22:4)

So which is it? Can we see His face, or will we die?

Both.

The Problem: Impurity Cannot Survive Holiness

When Moses asked to see Yahuah's glory, Yahuah responded:

"And He said, I will make all My goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of Yahuah before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy. And He said, Thou canst not see My face: for there shall no man see Me, and live." (Exodus 33:19-20)

Yahuah's face = His full, unfiltered glory.

No man can see it and live.

Why?

Because Yahuah is a consuming fire. His holiness is so intense, so pure, that anything impure in His presence is incinerated.

When Isaiah saw a vision of Yahuah's throne, he cried out:

"Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, Yahuah of hosts." (Isaiah 6:5)

"I am undone."

His response to seeing Yahuah was terror, not joy. He expected to die.

Why? Because he was unclean.

Impurity cannot survive in the presence of absolute holiness. It is like throwing gasoline on a fire.

The Solution: Purity Allows What Impurity Forbids

But Yahusha said:

"Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see Elohim." (Matthew 5:8)

Notice the condition: pure in heart.

Those who are pure shall see Elohim.

Not "might." Not "could." Shall.

And in the new creation:

"And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of Elohim and of the Lamb shall be in it; and His servants shall serve Him: and

they shall see His face; and His name shall be in their foreheads." (Revelation 22:3-4)

They shall see His face.

This is not a contradiction. This is a condition.

The impure cannot see His face and live. The pure can.

How Do You Become Pure?

You cannot make yourself pure. Purity is the result of the refining process.

Isaiah's vision continues:

"Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: and he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged." (Isaiah 6:6-7)

A live coal from the altar. Fire applied to the unclean lips.

The coal purged his sin. The fire made him clean.

This is the refining process.

You must go through the fire before you can stand in the Fire.

The Refining Happens Now

The trials you face now are the coal on your lips. The suffering, the persecution, the loss — these are the refining fire that burns away the impurity.

"But He knoweth the way that I take: when He hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold." (Job 23:10)

When the trial is over, you emerge as gold. Purified. Ready to stand in His presence.

Peter explains:

"That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Yahusha Messiah." (1 Peter 1:7)

Your faith is tested with fire now so that it can be found pure at His appearing.

If you refuse the refining now, you will not survive the Fire later.

Two Groups at His Return

When Yahusha returns in flaming fire, humanity will divide into two groups:

Group 1: The Impure (Chaff, Wood, Hay, Stubble)

Group 2: The Pure (Gold, Silver, Precious Stones)

The fire is the same. The response is different.

One group burns. The other shines.

The Impossible Becomes Possible

Exodus 33:20 — "No man can see My face and live."

Matthew 5:8 — "The pure in heart shall see Elohim."

Revelation 22:4 — "They shall see His face."

No contradiction.

The refining process makes the impossible possible.

What would kill you now will glorify you then.

But only if you submit to the refining.

Are you willing to let the coal touch your lips?

CHAPTER 5: THE TRIALS ARE THE REFINING

You are suffering.

Perhaps you lost your job because you refused to work on Sabbath. Perhaps your family rejected you when you left the traditions of Christmas and Easter. Perhaps you face ridicule, isolation, or persecution for obeying Torah.

You cry out to Yahuah: "Why is this happening to me?"

Here is the answer:

The trials are the refining.

Your current suffering is not punishment. It is preparation.

Refined in the Furnace of Affliction

"Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction." (Isaiah 48:10)

Yahuah does not refine you in comfort. He refines you in affliction.

The furnace is not random. It is chosen. Yahuah Himself places you in the fire.

Why?

Because affliction reveals what you are made of.

When life is easy, you can fake obedience. You can coast on emotions. You can pretend to have faith.

But when the fire comes — when you lose everything, when you stand alone, when obedience costs you dearly — the truth is revealed.

Are you gold, or are you dross?

The Trial of Your Faith

Peter explains why trials are necessary:

"Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: that the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Yahusha Messiah." (1 Peter 1:6-7)

Your faith is tested with fire.

Not because Yahuah doubts you, but because you need to see what you're made of.

Gold that has never been tested might be counterfeit. But gold that passes through the furnace is proven genuine.

Your trials now are the proof that your faith is real.

Do Not Be Surprised by the Fire

Many believers are shocked when persecution comes. They thought following Yahusha would bring health, wealth, and happiness.

Peter corrects this error:

"Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: but rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Messiah's sufferings; that, when His glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy." (1 Peter 4:12-13)

"Think it not strange."

The fiery trial is not strange. It is normal.

Every genuine follower of Yahusha will face the fire.

Paul confirms:

"Yea, and all that will live godly in Messiah Yahusha shall suffer persecution." (2 Timothy 3:12)

Not "might suffer." Shall suffer.

If you are not suffering persecution, examine yourself. You may not be living godly.

The Purpose of the Fire

The fire has a purpose. It is not random suffering. It is surgical precision.

1. The fire reveals what is hidden.

"Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is." (1 Corinthians 3:13)

The trial exposes your true foundation. You cannot hide in the furnace.

2. The fire purges what is impure.

"And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on My name, and I will hear them: I will say, It is My people: and they shall say, Yahuah is my Elohim." (Zechariah 13:9)

The dross rises to the surface. The impurities are skimmed off. What remains is pure.

3. The fire strengthens what remains.

"But He knoweth the way that I take: when He hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold." (Job 23:10)

Gold is soft until it is refined. The fire hardens it. Makes it durable. Fit for the Master's use.

The Greater the Trial, the Greater the Reward

James writes:

"Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Master hath promised to them that love Him." (James 1:12)

The trial is not the end. It is the path to the crown.

Paul adds:

"For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory." (2 Corinthians 4:17)

"Light affliction."

Paul was beaten, stoned, shipwrecked, imprisoned, and eventually martyred. He called this "light."

Why?

Because compared to the eternal weight of glory, even the worst suffering is momentary and light.

The fire you endure now is producing glory you cannot yet imagine.

Rejoice in the Fire

This sounds insane to the carnal mind. Rejoice in suffering?

But Peter commands it:

"But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Messiah's sufferings; that, when His glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy." (1 Peter 4:13)

You rejoice because:

Suffering now prevents destruction later.

Would you rather face the small fire now, or the consuming Fire at His return?

Practical Application

When you face trials:

1. Do not ask "Why me?" Ask "What is Yahuah refining?"
2. Do not try to escape the fire. Submit to the process.
3. Do not waste the trial. Let it burn away the dross.
4. Do not give up. Endure to the end.

"My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But

let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing." (James 1:2-4)

Count it all joy.

The fire is not your enemy. It is your preparation.

Stand in the furnace now, so you can stand in the Fire later.

PART 2: THE COSMOLOGICAL WAR

"And I saw a beast rise up out of the sea... And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority." (Revelation 13:1-2)

CHAPTER 6: BIBLICAL COSMOLOGY — THE DEEP (TEHOM)

Modern believers have abandoned biblical cosmology for the cosmology of secular science.

They believe in a globe spinning through infinite space, orbiting a sun, in a universe billions of years old.

But Scripture presents a different model.

A model where:

This is not allegory. This is cosmology.

And it is essential to understanding the End Times.

In the Beginning: The Deep (Tehom)

Genesis 1:2 describes the earth before Yahuah brought order:

"And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of Elohim moved upon the face of the waters." (Genesis 1:2)

The Hebrew word translated "deep" is Tehom(תְּהוֹם).

Tehom refers to the primordial chaotic waters. The realm of darkness. The Abyss.

Before creation was ordered, the Deep was the default state. Chaos. Darkness. The realm under judgment.

The Separation of the Waters

Yahuah's first act of creation was to separate the realms:

"And Elohim said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters. And Elohim made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so." (Genesis 1:6-7)

The firmament (Hebrew:raqia, a solid expanse) separates:

The firmament creates a boundary. A separation between the realm of Yahuah (above) and the realm of chaos (below).

The Throne Above the Waters

Psalms 29:10 reveals where Yahuah sits:

"Yahuah sitteth upon the flood; yea, Yahuah sitteth King for ever." (Psalms 29:10)

He sits above the waters. Above the firmament. Enthroned in the highest heaven.

Ezekiel saw the same vision:

"And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it." (Ezekiel 1:26)

The throne is above the firmament. The Most High dwells in the heights.

The Abyss Below

If the throne is above, what is below?

The Deep. The Abyss. The prison of fallen spirits.

Job describes the underworld:

"Hell is naked before Him, and destruction hath no covering. He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing." (Job 26:6-7)

The realm of the dead (Sheol/Hell) is "naked before Him" — exposed beneath the earth.

The earth "hangeth upon nothing" — suspended above the Abyss.

The Geography of the Underworld

The biblical model is simple:

ABOVE:Yahuah's throne, the third heaven, the realm of light and fire

MIDDLE:The firmament (sky), the earth, the seas

BELOW:The Deep (Tehom), the Abyss, Sheol/Hades, the prison of spirits

This is not metaphor. This is geography.

Paul confirms:

"Wherefore He saith, When He ascended up on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men. (Now that He ascended, what is it but that He also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?)" (Ephesians 4:8-9)

Yahusha descended into "the lower parts of the earth" — the realm of the dead beneath.

He ascended to "the heights" — the throne above.

The cosmology is vertical, not spherical.

Why This Matters for the End Times

The Beast does not rise from a human government alone.

The Beast rises from below. From the Abyss. From the prison of spirits.

The End Times is not just political. It is cosmological.

The powers bound in the Deep are being released.

And the Fire from Above is descending to destroy them.

You are standing in the middle of a war between the realm above and the realm below.

Choose your side carefully.

CHAPTER 7: THE SEA AS GATEWAY TO THE ABYSS

In biblical cosmology, the Sea is not merely water. It is the surface access point to the realm below.

The Abyss is the prison. The Sea is the gateway.

Jonah: Belly of Sheol in the Heart of the Seas

When Jonah was thrown overboard, he cried out from the depths:

"And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto Yahuah, and He heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, and Thou heardest my voice. For Thou hadst cast me into the deep, in the midst of the seas; and the floods compassed me about: all Thy billows and Thy waves passed over me." (Jonah 2:2-3)

"Out of the belly of hell" — literally, "belly of Sheol" in Hebrew.

Jonah was in the ocean. But he described it as Sheol. The realm of the dead.

He continues:

"The waters compassed me about, even to the soul: the depth closed me round about, the weeds were wrapped about my head. I went down to the bottoms of the mountains; the earth with her bars was about me for ever: yet hast Thou brought up my life from corruption, O Yahuah my Elohim." (Jonah 2:5-6)

"The earth with her bars was about me."

Bars. Prison language.

Jonah descended through the waters into the entrance of the underworld — the place of the dead, the realm beneath the foundations of the earth.

He was rescued from Sheol, not merely from drowning.

The Demons Fear the Abyss

When Yahusha confronted the man possessed by Legion (a multitude of demons), the demons begged Him:

"And they besought Him that He would not command them to go out into the deep." (Luke 8:31)

The Greek word for "deep" here is *abyssos* (■βυσσος) — the Abyss.

The demons feared being sent into the Abyss. Why?

Because the Abyss is their prison. The place of torment reserved for judgment.

They preferred to enter swine and drown in the Sea rather than be sent to the Abyss.

But notice: when the swine drowned in the Sea, the demons went into the waters.

The Sea is architecturally connected to the Abyss. It is the gateway.

Paul: Descending into the Deep

Paul equates the Deep with the realm of the dead:

"But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Messiah down from above:) or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Messiah again from the dead.)" (Romans 10:6-7)

"Descend into the deep" = "bring Messiah from the dead."

The Deep is the realm of death. The underworld. The place Yahusha descended after His crucifixion.

The Architectural Connection

Scripture consistently links the Sea with the Abyss:

The Sea and the Abyss are not synonymous, but they are connected.

The Sea is the surface. The Abyss is the depths beneath.

The Sea is the gateway through which the powers below can rise.

The Restraint

Currently, the Abyss is sealed. The fallen angels are bound. The Beast is restrained.

But the seal is breaking.

Revelation 9 describes the opening of the Abyss:

"And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit. And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit. And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power." (Revelation 9:1-3)

The key is given. The pit is opened. The smoke rises.

What comes out?

Demonic locusts. Powers that have been imprisoned since the Flood.

This is not allegory. This is literal release of bound spirits.

Why the Sea Imagery Matters

When Revelation says the Beast rises from the Sea (Revelation 13:1), it is not talking about a nation near the ocean.

It is saying the Beast's origin is the Abyss below.

The Sea is the visual symbol of the gateway. The Beast ascends through the waters from the prison beneath.

This is why the final enemy is both political (Rome/Papacy) and spiritual (demonic powers released from the Abyss).

The human system is the vehicle. The demonic realm is the power source.

You are not fighting flesh and blood. You are fighting principalities and powers from below.

And the Fire from Above is coming to destroy them.

CHAPTER 8: THE BEAST RISES FROM BELOW

Revelation describes the Beast with three different origin points — but they all say the same thing.

The Beast comes from below.

The Beast from the Sea

"And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy." (Revelation 13:1)

The Beast rises from the Sea.

In biblical cosmology, the Sea represents:

The Beast does not originate from human politics alone. It originates from the spiritual realm below.

The Beast from the Abyss

"And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them." (Revelation 11:7)

"The beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit."

The Greek word for "bottomless pit" is *abyssos*— the Abyss. The same word used in Luke 8:31 when the demons begged not to be sent there.

The Beast ascends from the Abyss.

The Beast from the Bottomless Pit (Again)

"The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is." (Revelation 17:8)

"Shall ascend out of the bottomless pit."

Again, the Abyss.

The Beast "was" (existed in the past), "is not" (currently restrained), and "shall ascend" (will be released in the end).

Three Descriptions, One Origin

This is not three different beasts. This is one Beast described from three angles.

The Sea is the gateway. The Abyss is the source. The Beast is the manifestation.

The Seven Heads

Revelation 17 explains the seven heads:

"And here is the mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth. And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space." (Revelation 17:9-10)

Seven mountains. Seven kings.

As proven in *Mystery Babylon Exposed*, the seven mountains are the seven hills of Rome. The woman (the Harlot) is the papal system sitting on Rome.

But the Beast beneath the Harlot is not merely human. It is the demonic power structure that has controlled empires throughout history.

The human system (Rome/Papacy) is the vehicle. The demonic realm (Abyss) is the engine.

The Dragon Gives the Beast Its Power

"And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority." (Revelation 13:2)

The dragon (Satan) gives the Beast:

The Beast is empowered by Satan. Its origin is spiritual, not merely political.

Why the Abyss Imagery Matters

Many assume the Beast is just a corrupt religious or political system.

But Revelation is clear: the Beast's ultimate origin is the Abyss. The demonic realm below.

This means:

Paul confirms:

"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places."
(Ephesians 6:12)

You are fighting powers from the Abyss.

And the Fire from Above is the only weapon that can destroy them.

CHAPTER 9: THE IMPRISONED POWERS

The Abyss is not empty. It is a prison.

And its inmates are waiting for release.

The Angels Who Sinned

Peter writes:

"For if Elohim spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be

reserved unto judgment..." (2 Peter 2:4)

The Greek word translated "hell" here is Tartarus (ταρταρ^ω) — a term used only once in Scripture. It refers to the lowest part of the underworld, the deepest prison.

These angels were:

They are not free. They are imprisoned.

But the imprisonment is temporary.

The Angels in Everlasting Chains

Jude confirms the same truth:

"And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, He hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day." (Jude 6)

"Everlasting chains under darkness."

These are the same angels Peter described. They are bound in the Abyss, under the earth, in chains of darkness.

What was their sin?

Jude provides the context by immediately mentioning Sodom and Gomorrah — cities judged for sexual immorality.

The connection points back to Genesis 6.

Genesis 6: The Sons of Elohim and the Daughters of Men

"And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, that the sons of Elohim saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they

took them wives of all which they chose... There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of Elohim came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown." (Genesis 6:1-2, 4)

"The sons of Elohim" is a technical term in Hebrew Scripture referring to angels (Job 1:6, 2:1, 38:7).

These angels ("Watchers" in the Book of Enoch) descended to earth, took human women as wives, and produced hybrid offspring called the Nephilim (giants).

This was not merely human sin. This was angelic rebellion — a violation of the created order.

The result was global corruption:

"And Yahuah saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually... The earth also was corrupt before Elohim, and the earth was filled with violence." (Genesis 6:5, 11)

Yahuah's response was the Flood. The judgment that destroyed the corrupted world.

But what happened to the angels who caused the corruption?

They were imprisoned in the Abyss.

Reserved for Judgment

2 Peter 2:4-5 links the imprisoned angels directly to the Flood:

"For if Elohim spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment; and spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly..." (2 Peter

2:4-5)

The angels were imprisoned. The world was flooded. Noah was saved.

The Flood was not just water. It was the judgment that sent the rebel angels to their prison.

And they have been there ever since — reserved for the final judgment.

The Release in the End Times

But Revelation 9 describes the opening of the Abyss:

"And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit. And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit." (Revelation 9:1-2)

A star (likely a fallen angel) is given the key. The pit is opened. Smoke rises like a furnace.

What comes out?

"And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power. And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of Elohim in their foreheads." (Revelation 9:3-4)

Demonic locusts with scorpion power. Commanded to torment those without the Seal of Yahuah.

These are not literal insects. They are the spirits imprisoned since the Flood, now released for the final hour.

As in the Days of Noah

Yahusha warned:

"But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." (Matthew 24:37)

"As the days of Noah."

What made Noah's days unique?

The End Times will mirror this pattern:

The imprisoned powers are being released. The Abyss is opening.

And when they ascend, the Beast rises with them.

CHAPTER 10: THE FIRE FALLS FROM ABOVE

The Beast rises from below. But the Fire descends from above.

This is the collision of realms.

Revealed in Flaming Fire

Paul describes the return of Yahusha with unmistakable clarity:

"And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Master Yahusha shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not Elohim, and that obey not the gospel of our Master Yahusha Messiah: who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Master, and from the glory of His power." (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9)

Notice the targets:

The fire is not random. It is judicial. It targets rebellion.

Coming with Fire and Chariots

Isaiah saw the same vision:

"For, behold, Yahuah will come with fire, and with His chariots like a whirlwind, to render His anger with fury, and His rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire and by His sword will Yahuah plead with all flesh: and the slain of Yahuah shall be many." (Isaiah 66:15-16)

He comes:

His rebuke is delivered with flames of fire. His sword pleads with all flesh.

The slain will be many.

The Day That Burns Like an Oven

Malachi prophesied:

"For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith Yahuah of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch." (Malachi 4:1)

The proud and the wicked will burn like stubble — dry straw in an oven.

Complete combustion. Total annihilation.

Not root. Not branch. Nothing remains.

Fire from Heaven Devours

At the end of the Millennium, when Satan is released for a final rebellion, the fire descends:

"And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from Elohim out of heaven, and devoured them." (Revelation 20:9)

Fire from heaven. Not from earth. Not from human weapons.

The fire originates from above.

This is Yahuah's fire. The fire of His presence. The consuming fire of His holiness.

The Elements Melt with Fervent Heat

Peter describes the scope of this fire:

"But the day of Yahuah will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up." (2 Peter 3:10)

The heavens pass away. The elements melt. The earth burns.

This is not a localized fire. This is cosmological purification.

Everything impure is consumed. Everything rebellious is destroyed.

Peter continues:

"Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of Elohim, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?" (2 Peter 3:11-12)

"What manner of persons ought ye to be?"

If the fire is coming, how should you live?

In holiness. In godliness. In obedience.

Build with gold, silver, and precious stones — materials that survive the fire.

The Collision of Realms

The End Times is the final battle between two opposing forces:

FROM BELOW: The Beast ascends from the Abyss, releasing the imprisoned powers, deceiving the nations, making war on the saints.

FROM ABOVE: Yahusha descends in flaming fire, accompanied by the armies of heaven, destroying the wicked, refining the righteous.

One rises. One descends. They collide.

And the Fire from Above prevails.

The Beast is cast into the lake of fire (Revelation 19:20). The imprisoned powers are destroyed. The earth is purified.

And the righteous — those refined by trials, purified by obedience, sealed by Yahuah — stand in the Fire and are not consumed.

They walk through the flame like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

The fire only burns their bonds.

CHAPTER 11: NO MORE SEA — THE FINAL VICTORY

Revelation 21 describes the new creation:

"And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea." (Revelation 21:1)

"No more sea."

This is not about literal oceans. This is about the abolition of the chaotic realm.

The Sea Represents Chaos and Death

Throughout Scripture, the Sea symbolizes:

When Revelation says "no more sea," it is declaring the complete destruction of the realm of chaos, rebellion, and death.

The Sea Gives Up the Dead

Before the new creation, the Sea is judged:

"And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works." (Revelation 20:13)

The Sea holds the dead. It is linked to death and Hades (the underworld).

But at the final judgment, the Sea releases its captives. Death and Hades are emptied.

And then:

"And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death." (Revelation 20:14)

Death itself is destroyed. Hades is cast into the lake of fire.

The realm of the dead is abolished.

No More Curse

In the new creation, the curse is removed:

"And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of Elohim and of the Lamb shall be in it; and His servants shall serve Him: and they shall see His face; and His name shall be in their foreheads." (Revelation 22:3-4)

No more curse. No more death. No more chaos.

The serpent's domain — the realm below, the Abyss, the Sea — is destroyed forever.

The Restoration of Genesis 1

Genesis 1 describes the original creation:

But the Deep was never fully eliminated. It was restrained, separated, but not destroyed.

Revelation 21 completes what Genesis 1 began:

The new creation is Eden restored — but greater. No serpent. No tempter. No possibility of rebellion.

The Dwelling of Yahuah

"And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of Elohim is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and Elohim Himself shall be with

them, and be their Elohim. And Elohim shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away." (Revelation 21:3-4)

Yahuah dwellswithmen. No separation. No barrier. No veil.

The fire that would have destroyed the impure has purified the righteous. They can now dwell in His presence forever.

No more tears. No more death. No more sorrow. No more pain.

The former things — including the Sea, the Abyss, the realm of chaos — are passed away.

The Final Victory

The war between the Fire from Above and the Beast from Below is not eternal. It has an end.

And the end is the complete, total, irreversible victory of Yahuah.

Nothing remains of the rebellion. Nothing survives of the Abyss.

Only the righteous — refined by fire, purified by trials, sealed by Yahuah — remain to dwell in the presence of the Consuming Fire forever.

The Fire from Above wins.

PART 3: THE REMNANT IDENTITY

"And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of Elohim, and have the testimony of Yahusha Messiah."(Revelation 12:17)

CHAPTER 12: WHO ARE THE REMNANT?

The world is filled with people who claim to follow the Messiah. Billions call themselves "Christians." Thousands of denominations exist.

But Scripture is clear: the remnant is small.

"Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it." (Matthew 7:13-14)

Few find it. Not many. Few.

Who are these few?

The Two Identifying Marks

Revelation gives us the answer:

"And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of Elohim, and have the testimony of Yahusha Messiah." (Revelation 12:17)

Two marks identify the remnant:

Not one without the other. Both.

Revelation 14:12 repeats the same formula:

"Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of Elohim, and the faith of Yahusha." (Revelation 14:12)

Notice: "the faith OF Yahusha," not "faith IN Yahusha."

This is not belief alone. This is the faithfulness of Yahusha — His obedience, His example, His way of life.

The remnant follows His example. They walk as He walked.

"He that saith he abideth in Him ought himself also so to walk, even as He walked." (1 John 2:6)

How did Yahusha walk?

The remnant does the same.

The Dragon's Specific Targets

Notice who the dragon attacks:

"And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of Elohim, and have the testimony of Yahusha Messiah." (Revelation 12:17)

The dragon is wroth (furious) with the remnant.

Why?

Because they refuse to compromise. They keep the commandments. They expose the lies. They stand in the truth.

The dragon does not make war with the Sunday-keeping, Christmas-celebrating, Trinity-teaching masses. He already owns them.

The dragon makes war with the remnant who have come out of Babylon and returned to the original faith.

Not Faith Alone, Not Works Alone

Many groups get half of the equation right:

Group 1: Faith Alone (Protestant Error)

James rebukes this:

"Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone." (James 2:17)

Dead faith. Useless. Does not save.

Group 2: Works Alone (Hebrew Roots Error)

Paul rebukes this:

"Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Yahusha Messiah." (Galatians 2:16)

Works alone cannot save. You need the Messiah.

The Remnant: Both

This is the narrow way.

Small, Scattered, and Despised

The remnant is not a megachurch. It is not a denomination. It is not organized under human leadership.

The remnant is:

"If the world hate you, ye know that it hated Me before it hated you. If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you." (John 15:18-19)

If you are popular, accepted, praised by the world and by mainstream religion, examine yourself.

The remnant is hated.

Are You Part of the Remnant?

Ask yourself:

If yes, you are the remnant.

Welcome to the war.

CHAPTER 13: THE 144,000

Revelation describes a specific group: the 144,000.

Who are they? Are they literal or symbolic? And how do they relate to the broader remnant?

Sealed from the Twelve Tribes

"And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel. Of the tribe of Juda were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand..." (Revelation 7:4-5)

The text is specific:

Some argue this is symbolic, representing the fullness of the redeemed from all nations.

Others argue this is literal — 144,000 physical descendants of the twelve tribes.

The answer is likely: both/and, not either/or.

The Father's Name in Their Foreheads

Revelation 14 gives more details:

"And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with Him an hundred forty and four thousand, having His Father's name written in their foreheads." (Revelation 14:1)

They have the Father's name (Yahuah) written in their foreheads.

This is the Seal of Yahuah — the opposite of the Mark of the Beast.

As explained in *The Mark You Already Have*:

The 144,000 have Yahuah's name in their forehead — they worship Him correctly, using His true name, keeping His true times and laws.

Not Defiled with Women

"These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto Elohim and to the Lamb." (Revelation 14:4)

"Not defiled with women."

In prophetic imagery, "women" often represent churches or religious systems (Revelation 17 — the Harlot).

The 144,000 are not defiled by false churches. They have not partaken in Babylon's fornication. They are spiritually pure.

"Virgins" — undefiled by the doctrines of demons, the traditions of men, the lies of Rome.

Follow the Lamb Wherever He Goes

"These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever He goeth." (Revelation 14:4)

Total obedience. Complete surrender. They follow Yahusha wherever He leads — even to death.

This is the faith OF Yahusha. His faithfulness reproduced in them.

Firstfruits unto Yahuah

"These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto Elohim and to the Lamb." (Revelation 14:4)

"Firstfruits."

In the feast cycle, Firstfruits is the beginning of the harvest (Leviticus 23:10-11). It precedes the full harvest.

The 144,000 are the firstfruits — the first wave of the redeemed, sealed before the great tribulation.

They are not the only ones saved. They are the first stones sealed.

Literal or Symbolic?

Here is the answer: Yes.

The 144,000 are likely a literal group — 12,000 from each tribe, physically descended from Israel, sealed for a specific role.

But they also represent the principle of the sealed remnant — those who have the Father's name, who are undefiled by Babylon, who follow the Lamb completely.

Whether you are one of the literal 144,000 or part of the broader remnant, the qualifications are the same:

Strive to be among them.

CHAPTER 14: THE GREAT MULTITUDE

After the 144,000 are sealed, John sees another group:

"After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands." (Revelation 7:9)

This is the great multitude. Innumerable. From every nation, tribe, people, and language.

Who Are They?

One of the elders explains:

"And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they? And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb." (Revelation 7:13-14)

"These are they which came out of great tribulation."

They endured the final persecution. They refused the Mark. They stood firm through suffering.

"And have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb."

They are saved by the blood of Yahusha. They repented, believed, and obeyed.

Before the Throne

"Therefore are they before the throne of Elohim, and serve Him day and night in His temple: and He that sitteth on the throne

shall dwell among them. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and Elohim shall wipe away all tears from their eyes." (Revelation 7:15-17)

They are before the throne. They serve Yahuah day and night. No more hunger. No more thirst. No more suffering.

The Lamb feeds them. Yahuah wipes away their tears.

This is the reward for enduring to the end.

The Relationship to the 144,000

How do the 144,000 relate to the great multitude?

Theory 1: Two Separate Groups

Theory 2: The 144,000 Are Part of the Multitude

Either way, the qualifications are the same:

The Nations Included

Notice: the great multitude is from "all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues."

This includes Gentiles. Non-Israelites. Those grafted into the olive tree (Romans 11:17-24).

Paul explains:

"For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: but he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of Elohim." (Romans 2:28-29)

A true Israelite is one who is circumcised of heart — who believes and obeys.

Gentiles who come to faith in Yahusha and obey Torah are grafted into Israel. They become part of the remnant.

The great multitude proves this. All nations. One people. One Messiah. One Torah.

Will You Be Among Them?

The great multitude came out of great tribulation. They endured suffering. They refused the Mark. They washed their robes in the blood of the Lamb.

Are you willing to endure?

Are you willing to stand firm when persecution comes?

Are you willing to lose everything — job, family, friends, life itself — to remain faithful?

If yes, you will be among the great multitude standing before the throne.

CHAPTER 15: FINDING THE REMNANT TODAY

If the remnant is real, where are they?

How do you find them? How do you join them?

Scattered, Not Centralized

The remnant is not organized into a single denomination or institution.

They are scattered across the earth — small fellowships, home groups, isolated believers walking in obedience to Torah and faith in Yahusha.

Why scattered?

Because every centralized religious institution in history has been corrupted. Power centralizes. Corruption follows.

Yahusha warned:

"For where two or three are gathered together in My name, there am I in the midst of them." (Matthew 18:20)

Two or three. Not two or three thousand.

The remnant gathers in small groups — often in homes, not in buildings with steeples and 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status.

Where to Look

1. Home Fellowships

Many remnant believers meet in homes on the Sabbath. They study Torah, pray, sing psalms, and break bread together.

These fellowships are usually small (5-20 people) and operate without formal hierarchy.

Look for local home fellowships that:

2. Online Communities

In the age of the internet, many remnant believers connect online. Groups exist on various platforms where Torah-observant, Messiah-believing people gather to study, encourage, and fellowship.

Be discerning. Not every group that claims to be "Torah-observant" holds to sound doctrine. Test everything (1 Thessalonians 5:21).

3. Individual Believers

Many in the remnant walk alone. They have no local fellowship. They study in isolation, worshiping Yahuah in truth even when surrounded by Babylon.

If this is you, do not despair. Elijah thought he was alone, but Yahuah had 7,000 who had not bowed to Baal (1 Kings 19:18).

You are not alone. The remnant exists. Keep seeking.

Warning Signs of False Remnant Groups

Not every group that claims to be the "remnant" is genuine. Beware of:

1. Cult-Like Control

If a group demands absolute obedience to a human leader, claiming he is a prophet or apostle with special revelation, flee.

"One is your Master, even Messiah; and all ye are brethren."
(Matthew 23:8)

No human mediator. Yahusha alone is Master.

2. Rejection of Yahusha

Some groups keep Torah but reject Yahusha as Messiah. They deny His deity, His virgin birth, His resurrection, or His role as Savior.

This is not the remnant. This is Judaism without the Messiah.

The remnant has BOTH: the commandments of Yahuah AND the testimony of Yahusha (Revelation 12:17).

3. Extreme Legalism

Some groups add burdens beyond what Scripture requires. They invent extra rules, extra restrictions, extra doctrines not found in Torah.

Yahusha rebuked this:

"But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in." (Matthew 23:13)

Obedience to Torah is required. But adding man-made rules to Torah is Pharisaism.

4. Obsession with Conspiracies

Some groups spend more time discussing flat earth, Nephilim, hidden prophecies, and secret knowledge than they do studying Torah and living in obedience.

Paul warns:

"Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do." (1 Timothy 1:4)

Focus on Torah. Focus on Yahusha. Focus on obedience. The rest is distraction.

How to Identify Genuine Believers

Look for these marks:

If you find such believers, fellowship with them. Build relationships. Support one another.

The remnant is stronger together.

What If You Cannot Find Anyone?

If you search and cannot find a local fellowship, you have two options:

1. Start One

Invite others to your home for Sabbath study. Share what you have learned. Pray, read Scripture, sing psalms, break bread.

Even if it is just you and one other person, Yahusha is in your midst (Matthew 18:20).

2. Walk Alone with Yahuah

If you must walk alone, you are in good company. Elijah walked alone. Jeremiah walked alone. Noah walked alone.

Better to walk alone in truth than to walk with a crowd in deception.

"And Enoch walked with Elohim: and he was not; for Elohim took him." (Genesis 5:24)

Enoch walked with Yahuah. He did not walk with the world.

And Yahuah took him.

Walk with Yahuah. The remnant will find you.

PART 4: RETURNING TO HIS WAYS

"Thus saith Yahuah, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye

shall find rest for your souls." (Jeremiah 6:16)

CHAPTER 16: THE SACRED NAMES — YAHUAH AND YAHUSHA

You cannot love someone whose name you do not know.

You cannot call upon a name you refuse to speak.

And you cannot be saved by a name that has been replaced with a substitute.

The sacred names matter.

YHWH — The Name of the Father

In the Hebrew Scriptures, the name of the Almighty appears 6,828 times.

The four Hebrew letters: **יהוה** (Yod-Hey-Waw-Hey).

Transliterated: YHWH.

Pronounced: Yahuah (Yah-oo-ah).

But in most English Bibles, this name has been completely removed.

Replaced with "the LORD" (all capitals).

This is not a translation. It is a title substitution.

Why the Name Was Hidden

The tradition of not pronouncing the sacred name began with the Jews during the time between the Testaments.

They feared violating the third commandment:

"Thou shalt not take the name of Yahuah thy Elohim in vain; for Yahuah will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain."
(Exodus 20:7)

But "taking His name in vain" does not mean pronouncing it. It means using it emptily, falsely, or irreverently.

Instead of being careful with His name, they stopped using it altogether.

Instead of reverence, they chose concealment.

The Command to Proclaim His Name

But Scripture commands the opposite:

"I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee." (Psalm 22:22)

"Sing unto Elohim, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name YAH, and rejoice before him." (Psalm 68:4)

"And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, Yahuah is my Elohim." (Zechariah 13:9)

You are commanded to call on His name. To proclaim His name. To praise His name.

You cannot do that with "the LORD."

Yahusha — The Name of the Son

The Son's name in Hebrew is: ■■■■■ (Yod-Hey-Waw-Shin-Ayin).

Pronounced:Yahusha(Yah-oo-shah).

It means:"Yahuah is Salvation."

The name contains:

The Son's namedeclares the Father's name.

The Connection Between the Names

"I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive." (John 5:43)

"I, even I, am Yahuah; and beside me there is no saviour." (Isaiah 43:11)

The Son came in the Father's name. He is the Father's salvation.

His name proclaims this truth:

Yahuah (Father) + Salvation (Yasha) = Yahusha

Why "Yeshua" is Insufficient

Some use "Yeshua" (the shortened Aramaic form) instead of "Yahusha."

But "Yeshua" drops the Yahu-prefix. It means only "salvation," without explicitly declaring whose salvation.

The full Hebrew name Yahusha contains the Father's name. The shortened Aramaic form does not.

Would you shorten your own child's name to the point where it loses its meaning?

Why "Jesus" Obscures Everything

"Jesus" comes from the Greek Iesous (Ἰησοῦς), a transliteration attempt of the Hebrew name into Greek.

But Greek has no "Y" sound, no "SH" sound, and no "AH" ending. The result is a name that:

The Messiah was not named "Jesus" by His mother. He was named Yahusha.

A Comparison

Salvation is in the Name

"Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." (Acts 4:12)

The name given for salvation is Yahusha.

Not a title. Not a translation. The name.

Returning to the Sacred Names

To return to His ways, you must return to His name.

Call upon Yahuah. Pray in the name of Yahusha.

Stop using substitutes. Stop using titles where names belong.

His name is not "the LORD." His name is Yahuah.

The Savior's name is not "Jesus." His name is Yahusha.

Use the names. Proclaim the names. Be saved by the name.

CHAPTER 17: THE SABBATH — HIS SIGN FOREVER

The Sabbath is not a Jewish tradition.

It is not "Old Testament law."

It is the sign between Yahuah and His people.

Forever.

The Sabbath in Creation

"And on the seventh day Elohim ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. And Elohim blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which Elohim created and made." (Genesis 2:2-3)

The Sabbath was established at creation, before there were any Jews, before the Law of Moses, before anything else.

Yahuah set apart the seventh day and made it holy.

The Fourth Commandment

"Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of Yahuah thy Elohim: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days Yahuah made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore Yahuah blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it." (Exodus 20:8-11)

This is the longest of the Ten Commandments. It is the only one that begins with "Remember"—because Yahuah knew we would forget.

The Sign of the Covenant

"Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant. It is a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for in six days Yahuah made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day he rested, and was refreshed." (Exodus 31:16-17)

The Sabbath is asign. It identifies who belongs to Yahuah.

It is aperpetual covenant— not temporary, not abolished, not "fulfilled" in Christ.

Which Day is the Sabbath?

The Sabbath is theseventh dayof the week.

In the Gregorian calendar, this isSaturday(sunset Friday to sunset Saturday).

Sundayis the first day of the week.

Constantine changed the day of worship to Sunday in 321 AD to honor the "venerable day of the sun" and distance Christianity from its Jewish roots.

This is the fulfillment of Daniel 7:25:

"And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws..." (Daniel 7:25)

The Little Horn power (Papal Rome)changed times and laws— specifically the Sabbath day.

Did Yahusha Change the Sabbath?

No.

"Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled." (Matthew 5:17-18)

Yahusha kept the Sabbath His entire life. He said not one letter of the Law would pass away.

He never commanded Sunday worship. The apostles never commanded Sunday worship.

The change came later, through Rome.

What About "Colossians 2:16"?

Many claim that Colossians 2:16 abolishes the Sabbath:

"Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Messiah." (Colossians 2:16-17)

But this passage does not say "do not keep the Sabbath." It says "let no man judge you for keeping the Sabbath."

Paul is defending Sabbath-keeping believers from critics.

The "sabbaths" mentioned here are likely the annual feast sabbaths (Leviticus 23), which are indeed shadows pointing to Messiah's work.

The weekly Sabbath is not a shadow. It is a memorial of Creation (Exodus 20:11).

The Sabbath in the New Earth

"For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith Yahua, so shall your seed and

your name remain. And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith Yahuah." (Isaiah 66:22-23)

In the new earth, all flesh will keep the Sabbath.

If it will be kept in eternity, why would it be abolished now?

How to Keep the Sabbath

1. Observe from Sunset to Sunset

The biblical day begins and ends at sunset (Genesis 1:5, "evening and morning").

The Sabbath begins at sunset on Friday and ends at sunset on Saturday.

2. Rest from Work

Do not work. Do not buy or sell. Do not conduct business (Nehemiah 13:15-22).

3. Gather for Worship

If possible, gather with other believers for Scripture reading, prayer, and fellowship (Leviticus 23:3).

4. Delight in Yahuah

"If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of Yahuah, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in Yahuah..." (Isaiah 58:13-14)

The Sabbath is not a burden. It is a delight.

It is rest for your body, renewal for your soul, and communion with your Creator.

The Sabbath and the Mark

In the end times, the Sabbath will be the dividing line.

Those who keep Yahuah's Sabbath (seventh day) will receive theseal of Yahuah.

Those who keep the counterfeit sabbath (Sunday) enforced by the Beast will receive themark of the Beast.

This is not legalism. This is covenant loyalty.

Return to the Sabbath. It is His sign. Forever.

CHAPTER 18: THE FEASTS OF YAHUAH

Most Christians celebrate Christmas and Easter.

But Yahuah never commanded either of these.

Instead, He gave seven appointed times— His feasts.

These are not "Jewish holidays." They are Yahuah's feasts.

"Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of Yahuah, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts." (Leviticus 23:2)

Not Israel's feasts. Yahuah's feasts.

The Seven Feasts of Leviticus 23

There are seven annual feasts (plus the weekly Sabbath):

Spring Feasts — Already Fulfilled

The first four feasts were fulfilled at Messiah's first coming:

Passover:Yahusha died on Passover, the 14th of the first month, as the Lamb of Yahuah (1 Corinthians 5:7).

Unleavened Bread:Yahusha was buried during the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Leaven represents sin; He was sinless.

Firstfruits:Yahusha rose from the dead on the Feast of Firstfruits, the day after the Sabbath during Unleavened Bread (1 Corinthians 15:20-23).

Pentecost:The Set-Apart Spirit was poured out 50 days after Firstfruits, on the Feast of Pentecost (Acts 2).

Fall Feasts — Still to Be Fulfilled

The final three feasts will be fulfilled at Messiah's second coming:

Trumpets (Yom Teruah):The Day of the Blowing of Trumpets pictures the return of Messiah with the sound of the trumpet (1 Thessalonians 4:16, Revelation 11:15).

Atonement (Yom Kippur):The Day of Atonement pictures the final judgment and cleansing of the heavenly sanctuary (Daniel 8:14, Hebrews 9:23-28).

Tabernacles (Sukkot):The Feast of Tabernacles pictures Yahuah dwelling (tabernacling) with His people in the New Earth (Revelation 21:3, Zechariah 14:16-19).

Why We Should Keep the Feasts

1. Yahuah Commanded Them "Forever"

"In the seventh month, in the fifteenth day of the month, shall he do the like in the feast of seven days... It shall be a statute for

ever throughout your generations..." (Leviticus 23:41)

The feasts are a perpetual statute. They were never abolished.

2. They Teach Prophetic Truth

The feasts are a roadmap of redemption. They show the plan of salvation from Passover (Messiah's death) to Tabernacles (eternal dwelling).

3. They Replace Pagan Holidays

Christmas (December 25) was originally the Roman festival of Saturnalia and the birthday of Sol Invictus (the sun god). Easter comes from Ishtar, a pagan fertility goddess. These holidays have pagan origins.

Yahuah's feasts have biblical origins.

4. Messiah Kept Them

Yahusha kept all the feasts (John 7:2, 10, 37). The apostles kept the feasts (Acts 20:6, 1 Corinthians 5:7-8). The early believers kept the feasts.

Why did the Church stop?

How to Observe the Feasts

Full instructions are found in Leviticus 23. Here is a summary:

Passover (14th of 1st month): Commemorate with a Passover meal (lamb, unleavened bread, bitter herbs). Remember Yahusha as the Passover Lamb.

Unleavened Bread (15th-21st of 1st month): Eat no leavened bread for seven days. Remove leaven from your home. Remember Yahusha's sinless life and burial.

Firstfruits (Day after Sabbath during Unleavened Bread): Offer a wave offering of the first harvest (or make a donation). Remember Yahusha's resurrection.

Pentecost (50 days after Firstfruits): Gather for worship and thanksgiving. Remember the outpouring of the Spirit.

Trumpets (1st of 7th month): Blow the shofar (ram's horn). Gather for worship. Remember Messiah's coming return.

Atonement (10th of 7th month): Fast and pray. Humble yourself before Yahuah. Remember the coming judgment.

Tabernacles (15th-21st of 7th month): Dwell in temporary shelters (booths/tents) if possible. Rejoice before Yahuah. Remember the wilderness journey and the future dwelling in the New Earth.

The Biblical Calendar

The feasts are based on the biblical calendar, which is lunar-solar (months based on the moon, years adjusted to the solar cycle).

The first month (Aviv/Nisan) begins in the spring, when the barley is ripe in Israel. This is usually March or April on the Gregorian calendar.

For exact dates each year, consult a biblical calendar resource (see Appendix B).

Come Out of Babylon

Celebrating Christmas and Easter while ignoring Yahuah's feasts is spiritual adultery.

It is mixing the holy with the profane. It is bringing pagan practices into worship of the Most High.

"Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues." (Revelation 18:4)

Come out. Stop celebrating pagan holidays. Return to Yahuah's appointed times.

Keep the feasts. They are His.

CHAPTER 19: CLEAN AND UNCLEAN — DIETARY LAWS

Modern Christianity teaches that all foods are now clean.

They cite Mark 7:19, Acts 10, and 1 Timothy 4:4 as proof that dietary laws have been abolished.

But a closer reading reveals something different.

The Dietary Laws in Leviticus 11

"And Yahuah spake unto Moses and to Aaron, saying unto them, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, These are the beasts which ye shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth..." (Leviticus 11:1-2)

Leviticus 11 and Deuteronomy 14 list which animals are clean (permitted to eat) and which are unclean (forbidden).

Clean Animals:

Unclean Animals (Forbidden):

Were Dietary Laws Abolished?

Many believe that the New Testament abolished these laws. Let us examine the passages:

Mark 7:19 — "Purifying All Meats"?

"Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?" (Mark 7:19)

This passage is about ceremonial handwashing, not dietary laws. The Pharisees accused Yahusha's disciples of eating with unwashed hands (Mark 7:2).

Yahusha's response: Food does not defile a person spiritually. What defiles is what comes from the heart (Mark 7:20-23).

The phrase "purging all meats" refers to the digestive process eliminating food, not declaring unclean animals suddenly clean.

Acts 10 — Peter's Vision

"And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending upon him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: Wherein were all manner of fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air. And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat. But Peter said, Not so, Lord; for I have never eaten any thing that is common or unclean." (Acts 10:11-14)

Peter refused to eat unclean animals even after walking with Yahusha for three years. If dietary laws had been abolished, Peter did not know about it.

But the vision was not about food. Peter himself explains:

"Ye know how that it is an unlawful thing for a man that is a Jew to keep company, or come unto one of another nation; but Elohim hath shewed me that I should not call any man common or unclean." (Acts 10:28)

The vision was about people, not pork. Yahuah was showing Peter that Gentiles could also receive salvation.

1 Timothy 4:4 — "Every Creature of Elohim is Good"?

"For every creature of Elohim is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving: For it is sanctified by the word of Elohim and prayer." (1 Timothy 4:4-5)

Notice the qualifier: "sanctified by the word of Elohim."

What does the Word of Elohim say about pigs and shellfish? They are unclean (Leviticus 11).

Paul is saying that food which is already sanctified by Scripture is good to eat with thanksgiving. He is not saying that unclean animals suddenly became clean.

Dietary Laws in the New Earth

"For, behold, Yahuah will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire and by his sword will Yahuah plead with all flesh: and the slain of Yahuah shall be many. They that sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens behind one tree in the midst, eating swine's flesh, and the abomination, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, saith Yahuah." (Isaiah 66:15-17)

At Yahusha's return, those eating swine's flesh (pork) will be destroyed.

If dietary laws were abolished, why would Yahuah judge people for eating pork at His return?

Health Benefits of Clean Foods

Beyond the spiritual command, there are practical reasons for the dietary laws:

Yahuah designed our bodies. He knows what is good for us.

How to Apply Dietary Laws Today

1. Eat Only Clean Meats

Stick to animals listed as clean in Leviticus 11 and Deuteronomy 14:

2. Avoid Unclean Meats

Do not eat:

3. Read Labels

Many processed foods contain pork byproducts (gelatin, lard, bacon bits). Check ingredients.

4. Do Not Be Legalistic

If you accidentally eat something unclean, or if you are served unclean food and did not know, you are not condemned. Yahuah looks at the heart.

But once you know the truth, obey.

Coming Out of Dietary Babylon

For many, giving up pork and shellfish is difficult. These foods are cultural staples.

But obedience to Yahuah is more important than cultural preference.

"Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of Elohim." (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Eating to the glory of Yahuah means eating according to His instructions.

Return to clean eating. Your body is the temple of the Set-Apart Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19).

Treat it as such.

CHAPTER 20: OTHER TORAH COMMANDS FOR TODAY

The Sabbath, feasts, sacred names, and dietary laws are the most visible commands that believers are called to return to.

But there are many other Torah commands that still apply today.

This chapter provides a brief overview of additional commands from the Law that remain in force.

1. Fringes (Tzitzit) on Garments

"Speak unto the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a ribband of blue: And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of Yahuah, and do them..." (Numbers 15:38-39)

The command to wear fringes (Hebrew:tzitzit) is a perpetual reminder to keep all of Yahuah's commandments.

Yahusha wore tzitzit (Matthew 9:20, 14:36 — "hem of his garment" is literally "tzitzit").

Many believers today attach tzitzit to their clothing or wear a tallit (prayer shawl) as a visible reminder.

2. Not Mixing Certain Fabrics

"Thou shalt not wear a garment of divers sorts, as of woollen and linen together." (Deuteronomy 22:11)

This command forbids wearing garments made of wool and linen woven together (Hebrew:shatnez).

The principle: Do not mix the holy (linen, used in priestly garments) with the common (wool, used for everyday clothing).

This is a symbolic command about separation and purity. While the letter of the law applies to fabric, the principle applies to life: do not mix the holy with the profane.

3. Leaving the Corners of Your Field

"And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not wholly reap the corners of thy field, neither shalt thou gather the gleanings of thy harvest. And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather every grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: I am Yahuah your Elohim." (Leviticus 19:9-10)

This command instructs landowners to leave a portion of their harvest for the poor and foreigners.

The principle: Generosity and care for the needy.

Application today: Give to the poor. Support the stranger. Do not hoard everything for yourself.

4. Honest Weights and Measures

"Ye shall do no unrighteousness in judgment, in meteyard, in weight, or in measure. Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: I am Yahuah your Elohim..." (Leviticus 19:35-36)

Do not cheat in business. Use honest measurements, honest pricing, honest dealings.

Application today: Integrity in all financial and business matters. No deceit, no fraud.

5. Do Not Add Tattoos or Cuttings

"Ye shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor print any marks upon you: I am Yahuah." (Leviticus 19:28)

This command forbids cutting the body or making permanent marks (tattoos) as pagan mourning practices.

The principle: Your body is the temple of the Set-Apart Spirit. Do not defile it with pagan practices.

Application: Avoid tattoos. If you already have them, you are not condemned — but do not add more.

6. Do Not Trim the Corners of Your Beard

"Ye shall not round the corners of your heads, neither shalt thou mar the corners of thy beard." (Leviticus 19:27)

This command forbids shaving styles associated with pagan worship.

Many Torah-observant men grow beards. This is not required for salvation, but it is an outward sign of obedience.

7. Avoid Cross-Dressing

"The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination unto Yahuah thy Elohim." (Deuteronomy 22:5)

Men and women should dress in ways that reflect their biological sex.

This command opposes gender confusion and the modern transgender agenda.

8. Guard Your Tongue

"Thou shalt not go up and down as a talebearer among thy people: neither shalt thou stand against the blood of thy neighbour; I am Yahuah." (Leviticus 19:16)

Do not gossip. Do not slander. Do not spread false reports.

Application: Guard your words. Speak truth in love.

9. Love Your Neighbor as Yourself

"Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am Yahuah." (Leviticus 19:18)

This is the second greatest commandment (Matthew 22:39).

It is found in the Torah. Yahusha did not invent it. He quoted it.

Which Laws Still Apply?

Many ask: "Which Old Testament laws do we have to keep?"

Here is a simple breakdown:

Moral Laws: Still binding (Ten Commandments, love your neighbor, sexual purity, honesty, etc.)

Civil Laws: Principles apply, specific penalties may not (e.g., we don't stone adulterers today, but adultery is still sin)

Ceremonial Laws: Fulfilled in Messiah (animal sacrifices, Levitical priesthood, temple rituals) but the appointed times (Sabbath and feasts) remain as memorials.

Food Laws: Still binding (clean vs unclean animals)

Separation Laws: Principles apply (separation from paganism, holiness, purity)

How to Approach Torah Obedience

1. Start with the Basics

Do not try to obey everything at once. Start with:

As you grow, Yahuah will reveal more.

2. Grace, Not Legalism

Obedience is a response to grace, not a means to earn salvation.

You are saved by faith in Yahusha. You obey because you love Him (John 14:15).

3. Do Not Judge Others

Everyone is at a different stage of growth. Do not judge those who are still learning.

Teach gently. Lead by example.

4. Focus on the Heart

"But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith Yahuah, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their Elohim, and they shall be my people." (Jeremiah 31:33)

The New Covenant does not abolish the Law. It writes it on our hearts.

Obedience flows from a transformed heart, not external compulsion.

Returning to Torah

Returning to Yahuah's ways is not legalism. It is covenant loyalty.

It is love expressed through obedience.

"If ye love me, keep my commandments." (John 14:15)

Yahusha did not abolish the commandments. He called us to keep them.

Return to Torah. Walk in His ways.

PART 5: PRACTICAL PREPARATION

"And take thou unto thee wheat, and barley, and beans, and lentiles, and millet, and fitches, and put them in one vessel, and make thee bread thereof... Thus shalt thou prepare thy bread." (Ezekiel 4:9, 15)

CHAPTER 21: SPIRITUAL PREPARATION

Physical preparation without spiritual preparation is useless.

You can stockpile food, build shelters, and prepare for every physical contingency — but if you are not spiritually ready, you will not endure.

Spiritual preparation is the foundation of everything else.

1. Know the Word

"Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." (Psalm 119:11)

You must know Scripture.

Not just read it occasionally. Not just listen to sermons. You must study, memorize, and internalize the Word of Yahuah.

Why?

Because in the coming persecution, you may not have access to a Bible. You may be imprisoned. You may be on the run. You may have your Scriptures confiscated.

The Word hidden in your heart cannot be taken from you.

Start memorizing key passages now:

See Appendix E for a complete Scripture memory list.

2. Develop a Prayer Life

"Pray without ceasing." (1 Thessalonians 5:17)

Prayer is your direct line to Yahuah.

In the trials ahead, you will need constant communion with Him. You will need His guidance, His strength, His peace.

How to develop a consistent prayer life:

3. Repent and Be Cleansed

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9)

You cannot stand in the consuming fire if you are harboring unconfessed sin.

Search your heart. Confess your sins. Repent of known disobedience.

Common areas requiring repentance:

Cleanse yourself now. Do not wait until the crisis comes.

4. Learn to Hear His Voice

"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me." (John 10:27)

In the days ahead, you will need to hear Yahuah's voice clearly.

He will tell you when to flee. When to stay. When to speak. When to be silent.

But if you have never learned to hear His voice, you will not recognize it in the crisis.

How to learn to hear His voice:

5. Die to Self

"Then said Yahusha unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it." (Matthew 16:24-25)

The refining fire burns away everything that is not gold.

Your pride. Your comfort. Your reputation. Your self-will.

These must die now, before the fire comes.

Because if you are still clinging to your own life when persecution arrives, you will deny Yahusha to save yourself.

Dying to self means:

6. Put on the Full Armor

"Put on the whole armour of Elohim, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against

flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." (Ephesians 6:11-12)

This is a spiritual war. You need spiritual armor.

The full armor of Elohim (Ephesians 6:14-18):

Put on this armor daily. You are in a battle whether you realize it or not.

7. Fast and Afflict Your Soul

"Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting." (Matthew 17:21)

Fasting breaks the power of the flesh and sharpens your spiritual sensitivity.

It humbles you. It reminds you that man does not live by bread alone (Matthew 4:4).

Types of fasting:

Begin incorporating regular fasting into your spiritual life now. It will prepare you for the deprivations ahead.

Spiritual Readiness Checklist

Ask yourself these questions:

If you answered "no" to any of these, begin working on that area now.

Spiritual preparation cannot be rushed. It takes time.

Start today.

CHAPTER 22: MENTAL PREPARATION

Your mind is a battlefield.

The enemy will use fear, doubt, confusion, and deception to break you.

If your mind is not prepared, you will crumble under pressure.

1. Understand What is Coming

"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge..." (Hosea 4:6)

You cannot mentally prepare for something you do not understand.

You must know the prophetic timeline. You must understand the mark of the Beast, the seal of Yahuah, the Sunday law, the persecution, the great tribulation.

Study Daniel. Study Revelation. Study Matthew 24. Study the prophets.

When the events unfold, you will not be shocked. You will recognize them.

2. Count the Cost

"For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?" (Luke 14:28)

Following Yahusha in the end times will cost you everything.

Your job. Your reputation. Your family relationships. Your freedom. Possibly your life.

Count the cost now. Decide now whether you are willing to pay it.

Because when the crisis comes, there will be no time to deliberate.

What you may lose:

Are you willing to lose all of this to remain faithful to Yahuah?

Decide now.

3. Develop Mental Toughness

Mental toughness is the ability to endure hardship, uncertainty, and suffering without breaking.

It is built through deliberate practice.

Ways to build mental toughness now:

4. Guard Your Mind from Deception

"And Yahusha answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you." (Matthew 24:4)

Deception is the primary weapon of the enemy in the end times.

False teachers. False prophets. False signs and wonders. False peace and safety.

How to guard against deception:

5. Prepare for Isolation and Loneliness

"I looked on my right hand, and beheld, but there was no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul." (Psalm 142:4)

Many believers will stand alone in the final crisis.

Your assembly may compromise. Your family may turn against you. Your friends may betray you.

You must be mentally prepared to walk alone if necessary.

Remember:

You are never truly alone if Yahuah is with you.

6. Overcome Fear

"Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy Elohim: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness." (Isaiah 41:10)

Fear is the enemy's primary weapon against you.

Fear of losing your job. Fear of losing your family. Fear of persecution. Fear of death.

But perfect love casts out fear (1 John 4:18).

How to overcome fear:

7. Cultivate Patience and Endurance

"Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of Elohim, and the faith of Yahusha." (Revelation 14:12)

The final crisis will not be a sprint. It will be a marathon.

You will need patience to endure prolonged suffering. You will need endurance to keep going when everything seems hopeless.

How to build patience and endurance:

Mental Preparation Checklist

Ask yourself these questions:

If you answered "no" to any of these, start working on that are now.

Your mind will either be your greatest strength or your greatest weakness.

Prepare it.

CHAPTER 23: PHYSICAL PREPARATION

Faith without works is dead (James 2:20).

While we trust Yahuah to provide, we are also called to be wise stewards and prepare practically for hardship.

Joseph stored grain for seven years of famine (Genesis 41). Noah built an ark before the flood. The wise virgins brought extra oil (Matthew 25:4).

Physical preparation is biblical.

1. Food and Water Storage

"Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest." (Proverbs 6:6-8)

When the mark of the Beast is enforced, you will not be able to buy or sell (Revelation 13:17).

You must have food and water stored before that time comes.

What to store:

Water storage:

How much to store:

Aim for 3-6 months minimum. A year is better.

Remember: You may also need to share with others who did not prepare.

2. Learn to Grow Food

"And Yahuah Elohim took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it." (Genesis 2:15)

If supply chains collapse or you cannot buy food, you will need to grow your own.

Start now:

Even if you live in an apartment, you can grow food in containers.

3. Basic First Aid and Medicine

Hospitals may not be accessible. Pharmacies may refuse to serve those without the mark.

You need basic medical knowledge and supplies.

First aid supplies:

Natural remedies (biblical and effective):

Learn basic skills:

4. Shelter and Warmth

You may need to flee to the wilderness (Revelation 12:6, 14).

Or you may lose your home and need to shelter elsewhere.

Essentials:

5. Tools and Skills

When modern conveniences fail, you will need practical skills.

Useful tools:

Useful skills:

6. Physical Fitness

"Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Set-Apart Spirit which is in you, which ye have of Elohim, and ye are not your own?" (1 Corinthians 6:19)

You may need to walk long distances. Carry heavy loads. Flee on foot. Work manually.

If you are physically weak or out of shape, you will struggle.

Build fitness now:

Take care of your body. It is a stewardship from Yahuah.

7. Financial Preparation

"And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name." (Revelation 13:17)

Eventually, money will be worthless to those without the mark.

But in the time before the mark is fully enforced, having financial margin can buy you time and flexibility.

Financial preparation:

8. Community and Networking

You cannot survive alone.

You will need a network of like-minded believers who can share resources, skills, and support.

Start building these relationships now. (See Chapter 24 for more on community.)

Balance Faith and Preparation

Some will say, "If you truly have faith, you don't need to prepare. Yahuah will provide."

But this is presumption, not faith.

Faith obeys when Yahuah says "build an ark" (Noah). Faith stores grain when Yahuah warns of famine (Joseph). Faith brings extra oil when the bridegroom delays (Matthew 25:4).

Prepare diligently. Trust Yahuah completely.

Preparation is not lack of faith. It is obedience to wisdom.

CHAPTER 24: COMMUNITY — FINDING AND BUILDING FELLOWSHIP

You cannot endure alone.

Yahuah designed us for community. For fellowship. For mutual encouragement and support.

In the final crisis, believers will need one another more than ever.

Why Community Matters

"Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up." (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)

Isolation makes you vulnerable.

Community provides:

The Remnant Community

The remnant will not be found in mainstream churches.

The remnant will be scattered, meeting in homes, in secret, in small groups.

"For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." (Matthew 18:20)

You do not need a building. You do not need a pastor. You do not need a 501(c)(3) organization.

You need two or three believers committed to obeying Yahuah.

How to Find Remnant Fellowship

1. Search Online Communities

There are growing online networks of Torah-observant believers:

Use these to connect with believers in your area.

2. Visit Small, Independent Fellowships

Look for:

Warning signs to avoid:

3. Start Your Own Fellowship

If you cannot find a faithful group, start one.

Invite others to your home for Sabbath study. Share what you have learned. Pray together. Break bread together.

Even if it is just you and one other person, you have a fellowship.

Building a Strong Community

1. Center on Scripture

The Word must be the foundation of your fellowship.

Read it together. Study it together. Memorize it together.

2. Keep the Sabbath Together

Weekly Sabbath gatherings build consistency and relationship.

Suggested format:

3. Celebrate the Feasts Together

The feasts of Yahuah are designed to be celebrated in community.

Gather for Passover. Celebrate Tabernacles together. Blow the shofar on Trumpets.

These gatherings strengthen bonds and build memories.

4. Share Resources

"And all that believed were together, and had all things common; and sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need." (Acts 2:44-45)

The early believers shared everything.

In the coming crisis, you will need to do the same:

5. Protect the Community

Not everyone who claims to be a believer is trustworthy.

Beware of infiltrators, informants, and false brothers.

"Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves." (Matthew 7:15)

Test those who seek to join your fellowship. Observe their fruit. Be wise as serpents, harmless as doves (Matthew 10:16).

What If You Are Alone?

If you cannot find any believers in your area, you are not without hope.

1. Walk with Yahuah

Enoch walked with Elohim alone (Genesis 5:24). Elijah stood alone (1 Kings 19:10). You can too.

2. Connect Online

While you may not have local fellowship, you can participate in online communities for encouragement and teaching.

3. Pray for Fellowship

Ask Yahuah to bring you into contact with other believers.

He knows where the remnant is. He will connect you if it is His will.

4. Be Patient

As the crisis intensifies, the remnant will become more visible.

Those who are now hidden will begin to stand up. You will find each other.

The Underground Church

As persecution increases, the church will go underground.

Meetings will be secret. Locations will change frequently. Trust will be essential.

This is not new. Believers in China, North Korea, Iran, and other hostile nations have practiced underground fellowship for decades.

Study their methods. Learn from their experiences.

The Western assembly will soon face what they have already endured.

Fellowship in the Wilderness

"And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of Elohim, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days." (Revelation 12:6)

Some believers will flee to the wilderness for safety.

If Yahuah calls you to do this, go with others if possible.

Community in the wilderness is even more critical. You will need one another to survive.

The Ultimate Fellowship

Remember: the goal is not just to survive.

The goal is to endure faithfully until Yahusha returns.

And when He comes, you will join the ultimate fellowship:

"After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; and cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our Elohim which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb." (Revelation 7:9-10)

Build community now. It will carry you through the fire.

CHAPTER 25: THE COMING TEST — WHEN SUNDAY LAW ARRIVES

The final test is coming.

Not someday. Not in the distant future.

Soon.

And the test will be simple:

Will you obey Yahuah, or will you obey the Beast?

The Sunday Law

The mark of the Beast will be enforced through a national Sunday law.

This law will require all people to worship on Sunday (the first day of the week) and will forbid Sabbath observance (the seventh day).

It will be presented as:

Most churches will celebrate it. Most Christians will comply.

But it is the mark of the Beast.

Why Sunday Law is the Mark

The mark of the Beast is not a physical chip or tattoo.

It is a sign of allegiance.

"And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws..." (Daniel 7:25)

The Little Horn power (Papal Rome) changed times and laws.

Specifically:

When you keep Sunday instead of the Sabbath, you acknowledge the authority of Rome over the authority of Yahuah.

This is the mark in your forehead (what you believe) and your hand (what you do).

The Seal of Yahuah

The Sabbath is the seal of Yahuah.

"Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths, to be a sign between me and them, that they might know that I am Yahuah that sanctify them." (Ezekiel 20:12)

A seal contains three elements:

The Sabbath commandment contains all three:

"For in six days Yahuah [NAME] made [TITLE: Creator] heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is [TERRITORY], and rested the seventh day: wherefore Yahuah blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it." (Exodus 20:11)

When you keep the Sabbath, you are sealed with the name and authority of Yahuah.

How the Law Will Be Enforced

The Sunday law will not be enforced all at once.

It will come in stages:

Stage 1: Voluntary Compliance

Sunday rest will be encouraged. Businesses will be incentivized to close on Sunday. Churches will promote "family day" and "day of rest."

Most will comply willingly.

Stage 2: Economic Pressure

Those who refuse to comply will face penalties:

Stage 3: Legal Enforcement

Sunday observance becomes law. Sabbath-keepers are labeled as enemies of the state, religious extremists, threats to peace and order.

Fines. Imprisonment. Persecution.

Stage 4: Death Decree

"And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed." (Revelation 13:15)

In the final stage, a death decree will be passed.

Those who refuse the mark will be sentenced to death.

This is when the great multitude is martyred (Revelation 7:9-14).

What You Will Face

When the Sunday law is enforced, you will face impossible choices:

The pressure will be immense.

Family members will plead with you to comply. Friends will abandon you. Employers will threaten you. The government will hunt you.

You will be tempted to rationalize:

But compromise is apostasy.

Do Not Take the Mark

"If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, the same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of Elohim, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: and the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name." (Revelation 14:9-11)

This is the most severe warning in all of Scripture.

There is no forgiveness for taking the mark.

No second chance. No grace. No mercy.

Once you take the mark, your destiny is sealed.

Do not take it. No matter what.

What to Do When It Comes

1. Stand Firm

"Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of Elohim, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand." (Ephesians 6:13)

Do not waver. Do not compromise. Stand.

2. Flee if Necessary

"When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains." (Matthew 24:15-16)

Yahusha commanded His followers to flee when persecution comes.

If Yahuah tells you to leave, leave immediately. Do not look back (Luke 17:31-32).

3. Trust Yahuah to Provide

"But seek ye first the kingdom of Elohim, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." (Matthew 6:33)

Yahuah fed Elijah by ravens (1 Kings 17:4-6). He multiplied the widow's oil (1 Kings 17:14-16). He provided manna in the wilderness (Exodus 16).

He will provide for you.

4. Prepare for Martyrdom

"Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto

death, and I will give thee a crown of life." (Revelation 2:10)

Not all will escape. Many will be martyred.

If Yahuah calls you to die for Him, count it an honor.

Your death will be a testimony. Your reward will be eternal.

The Time is Short

The Sunday law is coming.

The signs are everywhere:

It could happen this year. It could happen next year.

But it is coming.

Prepare now. Decide now. Stand now.

Because when the test comes, there will be no time to prepare.

PART 6: THE FINAL CHOICE

"And if it seem evil unto you to serve Yahuah, choose you this day whom ye will serve... but as for me and my house, we will serve Yahuah." (Joshua 24:15)

CHAPTER 26: THE MARK OR THE SEAL — YOUR DECISION

It all comes down to this.

After everything you have learned. After all the preparation.
After all the warnings.

It comes down to one choice.

Will you take the mark of the Beast, or will you receive the seal of Yahuah?

There is no third option. There is no middle ground. There is no neutrality.

You will serve one master or the other.

Two Marks, Two Masters

"No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve Elohim and mammon." (Matthew 6:24)

The mark of the Beast representssubmission to human authority.

It is obedience to the commandments of men rather than the commandments of Yahuah.

When you keep Sunday instead of the Sabbath, you acknowledge the authority of the Beast power (Papal Rome) to change Yahuah's law.

This is the mark in yourforehead(your belief) and yourhand(your actions).

The seal of Yahuah representssubmission to divine authority.

It is obedience to the commandments of Yahuah, regardless of what men command.

When you keep the Sabbath, you acknowledge Yahuah as your Creator and King.

This is the seal in yourforehead.

The Choice is Yours

Yahuah will not force you to choose Him.

He gives you free will. He gives you the ability to choose.

"I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live."
(Deuteronomy 30:19)

He has set before you:

Choose.

What Choosing the Mark Means

If you take the mark of the Beast, here is what you choose:

"For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?" (Mark 8:36)

And the consequences are eternal:

"The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of Elohim, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: and the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name."
(Revelation 14:10-11)

There is no forgiveness for taking the mark.

No second chance. No grace after the fact. Your choice is final.

What Choosing the Seal Means

If you receive the seal of Yahuah, here is what you choose:

But you also choose:

"Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy master." (Matthew 25:21)

The Deception: "It's Just One Day"

Many will rationalize compliance with the Sunday law:

"It's just one day. Yahuah will understand. I can still worship Him in my heart."

But this is the lie of the serpent.

Yahuah does not accept partial obedience.

"For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all." (James 2:10)

The Sabbath is not "just one day." It is the sign of your allegiance.

It is the visible, public declaration of who you serve.

When you compromise on the Sabbath, you declare that you serve the Beast, not Yahuah.

The Cost of Obedience

Yes, keeping the Sabbath will cost you.

You may lose your job. You may lose your ability to buy food. You may lose your freedom. You may lose your life.

But what you gain is infinitely greater than what you lose.

"For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not

seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal." (2 Corinthians 4:17-18)

This life is temporary. The kingdom is eternal.

Do not trade eternity for comfort.

The Pressure Will Be Immense

When the Sunday law is enforced, you will face pressure from every side:

And inside, you will hear the voice of doubt:

This is when you must stand on the Word, not your feelings.

The Word is clear. The Sabbath is the seventh day. It is the sign of Yahuah. It is non-negotiable.

How to Stand Firm

1. Decide Now

Do not wait until the crisis comes to decide.

Decide today that you will obey Yahuah, no matter the cost.

Write it down. Speak it aloud. Make a covenant with Yahuah.

2. Hide the Word in Your Heart

When the pressure comes, you will need the Word to stand on.

Memorize key passages. Know the Sabbath commandment by heart. Know the warnings against taking the mark.

3. Pray for Strength

"Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." (Matthew 26:41)

You cannot stand in your own strength. You need the strength of Yahuah.

Pray daily for endurance. Pray for courage. Pray for faith.

4. Surround Yourself with Believers

If you stand alone, you are more vulnerable to compromise.

Surround yourself with others who are committed to obedience.

Encourage one another. Strengthen one another. Hold one another accountable.

5. Focus on Eternity

This life is a vapor (James 4:14). It is here for a moment, then gone.

But eternity is forever.

Keep your eyes on the prize:

"For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." (Romans 8:18)

The Dividing Line

The Sabbath is the dividing line between the remnant and the world.

It always has been.

In the final crisis, it will be the visible test of loyalty.

Those who keep the Sabbath will be sealed. Those who keep Sunday will be marked.

Which side will you be on?

Choose This Day

"And if it seem evil unto you to serve Yahuah, choose you this day whom ye will serve... but as for me and my house, we will serve Yahuah." (Joshua 24:15)

The choice is yours.

No one can make it for you. Not your pastor. Not your family. Not your friends.

You, and you alone, will stand before Yahuah and give account.

Choose wisely.

Choose life.

Choose the seal.

CHAPTER 27: ENDURING TO THE END

Choosing the seal is not the end.

It is the beginning.

After you make the choice, you must endure.

"But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved." (Matthew 24:13)

Salvation is not just for those who start. It is for those who finish.

The Long Test

The final crisis will not be a short trial.

It will be a long, grinding test of your faith, your endurance, your commitment.

Days will turn into weeks. Weeks will turn into months. Months may turn into years.

And every day, you will face:

Many who start strong will fall away.

"And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another." (Matthew 24:10)

But those who endure to the end will be saved.

How to Endure

1. Daily Dependence on Yahuah

"Give us this day our daily bread." (Matthew 6:11)

You cannot endure on yesterday's strength.

You must go to Yahuahevery dayfor fresh grace, fresh strength, fresh manna.

Those who try to coast on past faith will collapse.

2. One Day at a Time

"Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof." (Matthew 6:34)

Do not think about next month. Do not think about next year.

Focus on today.

Can you obey Yahuahtoday? Then do it.

Tomorrow will have its own challenges. But today, stand.

3. Remember Past Faithfulness

When you are tempted to give up, remember how Yahuah has brought you this far.

He delivered Israel from Egypt. He brought them through the Red Sea. He fed them in the wilderness.

He has never failed you. He will not fail you now.

"Yahuah hath been mindful of us: he will bless us..." (Psalm 115:12)

4. Cling to Promises

The Word of Yahuah is full of promises for those who endure.

Memorize them. Speak them aloud. Pray them back to Yahuah.

Key promises for endurance:

"Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy Elohim: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness." (Isaiah 41:10)

"And Yahuah, he it is that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed." (Deuteronomy 31:8)

"For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of Elohim, which is in Messiah Yahusha our Master." (Romans 8:38-39)

5. Fellowship with Other Believers

Isolation breeds despair.

If possible, stay connected with other believers who are also standing firm.

Encourage one another. Pray for one another. Strengthen one another.

"And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." (Hebrews 10:24-25)

6. Do Not Look Back

"Remember Lot's wife." (Luke 17:32)

Lot's wife looked back at Sodom and turned into a pillar of salt.

Do not look back at your old life. Do not long for the comforts you gave up.

Fix your eyes on the kingdom ahead.

7. Joy in Suffering

"Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you." (Matthew 5:12)

This may sound impossible. How can you rejoice in suffering?

Because suffering for Yahusha is an honor.

The apostles rejoiced that they were counted worthy to suffer for His name (Acts 5:41).

Paul and Silas sang hymns in prison (Acts 16:25).

Stephen prayed for his murderers as they stoned him (Acts 7:60).

This is the spirit of the martyrs. This is how you endure.

The Refining Fire

The tribulation is not meant to destroy you.

It is meant to refine you.

"But he knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold." (Job 23:10)

Gold is refined by fire. The dross is burned away. The pure gold remains.

You are the gold. The fire is the tribulation.

When you come through the fire, you will be pure, tested, proven.

When You Are Weak

There will be days when you feel like you cannot go on.

Days when your faith feels weak. Days when you doubt. Days when you are exhausted, hungry, afraid.

This is normal.

Even Elijah wanted to die (1 Kings 19:4). Even David felt abandoned (Psalm 22:1). Even Yahusha cried out, "My Elohim, my Elohim, why hast thou forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46).

You are not alone in your weakness.

But here is the key:

"And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness." (2 Corinthians 12:9)

When you are weak, His strength is made perfect.

Lean on Him. Cry out to Him. He will carry you.

Do Not Give Up

"And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not." (Galatians 6:9)

The Enemy wants you to give up.

He will whisper:

These are lies.

You are strong enough — in Yahuah's strength.

Yahuah has not abandoned you. He is with you every step.

And it is worth it. Eternity is worth it.

Do not give up.

The Finish Line

"I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Master, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing." (2 Timothy 4:7-8)

Paul finished his race.

He endured to the end.

And now, a crown awaits him.

You can do the same.

Run your race. Fight your fight. Endure to the end.

The crown is waiting.

CHAPTER 28: MARANATHA — THE KING IS COMING

After all the suffering. After all the trials. After all the darkness.

He is coming.

Maranatha. The Master is coming.

"Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen." (Revelation 1:7)

This is the hope of the remnant.

This is the promise that sustains you through the fire.

Yahusha is coming back.

The Appearing of the King

"For the Master himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of Elohim: and the dead in Messiah shall rise first: then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Master in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Master." (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17)

When He returns, it will be unmistakable.

Not a secret rapture. Not a quiet appearing. Not a spiritual metaphor.

He will descend with a shout. With the voice of the archangel.
With the trumpet of Elohim.

Every eye will see Him (Revelation 1:7).

The sky will split open. The clouds will roll back. And there, in
blazing glory, will be Yahusha, the King of kings.

Fire from Heaven

"And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Master shall
consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the
brightness of his coming." (2 Thessalonians 2:8)

The Beast. The False Prophet. All who took the mark.

They will be consumed by the fire of His presence.

The brightness of His coming will destroy them.

This is the consuming fire we have been preparing for.

The wicked will burn like wood, hay, and stubble.

But the righteous — those who have been refined like gold —
will stand in the fire unharmed.

The Resurrection

"And the dead in Messiah shall rise first." (1 Thessalonians
4:16)

At the sound of the trumpet, the graves will burst open.

Those who died in faith will rise, clothed in immortality.

"For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality." (1 Corinthians 15:53)

The martyrs will rise. The faithful will rise.

Death will be swallowed up in victory (1 Corinthians 15:54).

The Gathering

"And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other." (Matthew 24:31)

And now you stand on the sea of glass, holding a harp, singing the song of Moses and the Lamb.

The Wedding Supper

"Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb." (Revelation 19:9)

This is the ultimate fellowship. The ultimate celebration.

Every sacrifice will be worth it.

Every tear will be worth it.

Every moment of persecution will be worth it.

Because you will be home.

Even So, Come

"He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Master Yahusha." (Revelation 22:20)

This is the cry of the remnant.

Maranatha. Come, Master Yahusha.

Come quickly.

We are waiting.

We are ready.

We have endured the fire.

Now come, and take us home.

CONCLUSION: STAND IN THE FIRE

You have reached the end of this book.

But you have not reached the end of the journey.

The fire is coming.

The question is: Will you stand?

"Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter. If it be so, our Elohim whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up." (Daniel 3:16-18)

Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego stood in the fire.

They chose obedience over safety. They chose Yahuah over the king. They chose the flames over the image.

And when they walked into the furnace, Yahusha walked with them.

"Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of Elohim." (Daniel 3:25)

The fire did not destroy them. It only burned their bonds.

This is your promise.

When you stand in the consuming fire of Yahuah's presence, everything that is not of Him will burn away.

Your pride. Your self-will. Your fleshly desires. Your love of the world.

The Choice is Before You

This book has laid out the truth.

When everything falls apart. When the world turns against you. When you lose everything.

Stand on the Word. Stand on the promises. Stand on your faith.

Do not waver. Do not compromise. Do not give in.

Stand.

You Are Not Alone

As you prepare for what is coming, remember: you are not alone.

There is a remnant. Scattered, yes. Small, yes. But faithful.

All over the earth, believers are waking up to the truth. They are returning to the Sabbath. They are calling on the sacred names. They are preparing for the fire.

You are part of that remnant.

And when Yahusha returns, the remnant will be gathered.

APPENDIX A: COMPLETE SABBATH KEEPING GUIDE

The Sabbath is the fourth commandment and the sign of Yahuah's covenant with His people. This guide provides practical instructions for keeping the Sabbath.

1. When Does the Sabbath Begin and End?

The Sabbath begins at sunset on Friday and ends at sunset on Saturday.

"And the evening and the morning were the first day." (Genesis 1:5)

The biblical day begins and ends at sunset, not midnight.

How to determine sunset time:

2. Preparing for the Sabbath

Preparation Day (Friday) is when you prepare everything you need for the Sabbath.

3. What is Considered "Work"?

"Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of Yahuah thy Elohim: in it thou shalt not do any work..." (Exodus 20:9-10)

4. Sabbath Worship and Fellowship

"Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." (Hebrews 10:25)

If your job requires work on Sabbath:

7. Sabbath Travel

The concept of a "Sabbath day's journey" comes from Acts 1:12 (about 2,000 cubits, or roughly 3/4 of a mile).

This was a rabbinic restriction, not a biblical command. However, the principle is valid: avoid unnecessary travel on the Sabbath.

Acceptable Sabbath travel:

Avoid:

8. Ending the Sabbath (Havdalah)

When the sun sets on Saturday evening, the Sabbath ends.

Some believers practice a brief ceremony called Havdalah (separation) to mark the end of Sabbath:

This is not required, but it can be a meaningful way to transition back to the workweek.

9. Common Questions

Q: Can I use electricity on the Sabbath?

A: Yes. Turning on lights, using appliances, etc., is not "work" in the biblical sense. The Pharisees created elaborate restrictions around this, but Yahusha rebuked them for adding burdens to the Law.

Q: Can I drive a car on Sabbath?

A: Yes, if necessary (e.g., to attend worship, visit the sick). Avoid unnecessary travel for personal pleasure.

Q: Can I eat out at a restaurant on Sabbath?

A: This is debatable. Eating out requires others to work on Sabbath (cooks, servers). It also involves buying and selling. Most Sabbath-keepers avoid restaurants on Sabbath.

Q: What if I have an emergency on Sabbath?

A: Works of necessity and mercy are always permitted (Matthew 12:11-12). Care for the sick, respond to emergencies, help those in need.

10. The Heart of Sabbath

"If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of Yahuah, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine

own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in Yahuah..." (Isaiah 58:13-14)

The Sabbath is not about legalistic rule-keeping. It is about delighting in Yahuah.

It is a day to:

Approach the Sabbath with joy, not dread. It is a gift, not a burden.

A: The name Yahuah appears in ancient Hebrew inscriptions and manuscripts. The pronunciation is preserved in the shortened form "Yah" (Psalm 68:4) and in names like Eliyahu (Elijah = "My Elohim is Yah").

Q: Why do different groups pronounce it differently?

A: Because the original Hebrew vowel pointing was lost. However, linguistic and historical evidence supports "Yahuah" over other variants.

Q: Is it a sin to say "Jesus"?

A: If you did not know the correct name, no condemnation. But once you know, use the correct name. Salvation is in the name of Yahusha (Acts 4:12).

Q: Should I correct others who use "Jesus" or "the LORD"?

A: Teach gently. Do not be legalistic or condemn others. Focus on your own obedience and set an example.

APPENDIX D: COMING OUT OF BABYLON CHECKLIST

"Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues." (Revelation 18:4)

Babylon represents the corrupted religious system that mixes pagan practices with worship of the Almighty. This checklist helps you identify and remove Babylonian influences from your life.

1. Worship Practices to Abandon

■ Sunday worship— Return to the seventh-day Sabbath (Saturday)

■ Christmas (December 25) — Pagan festival of Saturnalia/Sol Invictus, not the birth of Messiah

■ Easter— Named after Ishtar, pagan fertility goddess; replaced with Passover observance

■Lent— 40 days of weeping for Tammuz (Babylonian god, see Ezekiel 8:14)

■Halloween— Celtic/pagan festival of Samhain, celebrating the dead

■New Year's Day(January 1) — Pagan calendar; biblical new year is in the spring (first month, Aviv)

2. Doctrines to Reject

■The Trinity— Not found in Scripture; added at Council of Nicaea (325 AD)

■Immortal soul— Greek philosophy, not biblical (Ezekiel 18:4, "the soul that sinneth, it shall die")

■Eternal hellfire— The wicked are destroyed, not tormented forever (Malachi 4:1-3, they become ashes)

■Sunday as the Lord's Day— Changed by Rome; the Sabbath is the seventh day

■Secret rapture— Not biblical; Yahusha's return will be visible to all (Revelation 1:7)

■Purgatory— Catholic invention with no scriptural basis

■Praying to saints/Mary— Forbidden; pray only to Yahuah (1 Timothy 2:5, one mediator)

■Infant baptism— Not commanded; baptism requires repentance and faith

3. Practices to Adopt (Returning to His Ways)

■Keep the seventh-day Sabbath(sunset Friday to sunset Saturday)

■Observe Yahuah's feast days(Leviticus 23: Passover, Unleavened Bread, Firstfruits, Pentecost, Trumpets, Atonement, Tabernacles)

■Use the sacred names(Yahuah, Yahusha) instead of titles (LORD, God, Jesus)

■Follow dietary laws(clean vs. unclean animals, Leviticus 11)

■Obey the Ten Commandmentsas written (including the Sabbath)

■Study Torahand apply its principles to daily life

■Pray directly to Yahuahin the name of Yahusha (no intermediaries)

4. Physical Items to Remove

■Christmas tree and decorations(Jeremiah 10:2-4 warns against this practice)

■Easter eggs, bunnies, and symbols(pagan fertility symbols)

■Crosses and crucifixes(ancient pagan symbol; focus on the resurrected Messiah, not the instrument of death)

■Images of "Jesus"(often based on pagan gods like Zeus; violates second commandment)

■Statues, icons, or religious idols(Exodus 20:4-5)

■Amulets, crystals, or New Age items(witchcraft and divination)

Matthew 6:25-26 "Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?"

Philippians 4:19 "But my Elohim shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Messiah Yahusha."

Ezekiel 20:12 "Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths, to be a sign between me and them, that they might know that I am Yahuah that sanctify them."
